CONSULTATIONS

New York maternal health providers can join and benefit from case-based learning with their peers. Consultation with expert psychiatrists in maternal mental health is available through an open conference line on **Tuesdays from 3-4PM** and **Thursdays from 1-2PM**. This hour-long open conference call will start with facilitated discussion followed by the opportunity to ask specific questions. Any provider may schedule in advance a specific ten-minute window to call in and present a brief case or question and get a response. Providers may join the entire call or call in only for their scheduled consultation time.




LINKAGES & REFERRALS
